

Supplementary Information for Registration for the 14th World Wushu Championships

1. Confirmation of Submission

Please fully complete and save each section of the online registration and submit it once complete. Once a registration is completed successfully, you will receive a confirmation email. If you do not receive a confirmation email within 24 hours, please review your submission and make sure it is completed and submitted, or contact the IWUF Secretariat through events@iwuf.org immediately.

2. Required Certificates

In the registration system, on the left panel, you will see a clickable button named "Upload Certificate" (screen shot attached). We request that you firstly complete and save all your delegation's registration within the various sections of the registration up until the "Submit" section. Prior to the final submission of your registration, please click on the "Upload Certificate" button and you will see all your registered participants for the event. You will then need to click on the "Upload/Modify" button next to each person and then you will need to upload the relevant documents required. The accepted file formats are JPEG or PDF and the maximum file size for each document is 10mb.

As of this year, the IWUF Medical Committee has prepared a standardized IWUF Medical Certificate document, which is required to be fully completed in English by the doctor checking the athlete and confirmed by the respective federation representative. This form is attached to this email, and is required to be uploaded into the system as the valid medical certificate stipulated above.

All original documents stipulated above must also be brought to Kazan by the respective team leader.

3. Accommodation Update

- **Athletes, Coaches, Team Leaders & Doctors:**
 - US\$50 per person per day (triple occupancy room) – Athlete’s Village
 - US\$65 per person per day (double occupancy room) – Athlete’s Village
 - US\$75 per person per day (single occupancy room) – Athlete’s Village
 - Should Team Leaders desire, they may lodge at the 4 Star Hotel (Relita Hotel) - US\$80 per person per day (single occupancy)
