SANCTION

The IWUF Executive Board, upon its Anti-doping Disciplinary Committee's ("ADDC") Sanction Recommendation on 27th January 2016 and through consultation with its Executive Board members has decided to impose the following **sanctions** on Mr. DMYTRO BATOK, Ukrainian Wushu athlete, born on 12th June 1991:

1. IWUF **disqualifies** the athlete from the Sanda/85kg event of the 13th World Wushu Championships which he placed the second;
2. IWUF **withdraws** the athletes' Silver medal and diploma in the above-mentioned event;
3. IWUF **imposes** a 24-month period of ineligibility for Wushu competition at all levels and any Wushu-related activity commencing from 18th November 2015 (sample collection date) and concluding (but inclusive of) on 17th November 2018.

Pursuant to 2015 IWUF Anti-doping Rules Article 13.2.1, Appeals Involving International-Level Athletes or International Events, Mr. DMYTRO BATOK has the right to appeal this decision to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) *within twenty-one (21) days from the date of receipt of this decision and notification* in accordance with Article 13.7, Time for Filing Appeals.
