

Decision of IWUF Anti-Doping Disciplinary Committee

dated 1 June 2019

Doping Case 2018 - IC 03 Seyedmoein TAGHAVI

Athlete / NF: Seyedmoein TAGHAVI / IRI Event: 9th Sanda World Cup, Hangzhou, China Date: 27-28 October 2018 Prohibited Substances: stanozolol metabolites

The IWUF Anti-Doping Disciplinary Committee ("ADDC") decided:

- According to the article 10.2.1 of IWUF Anti-Doping Rules 2015 to impose on the Athlete a period of four (4) years' ineligibility, starting on 27 October 2018 (sample collection date) and concluding (but inclusive of) on 26 October 2022 for his first Anti-Doping Rule Violation (ADRV).
- 2. All the results achieved by the Athlete at the Event are disqualified, including forfeiture of medals, prizes.
- 3. Prohibit the Athlete from participating in any capacity in a Competition or other sport-related activity under the authority of any Signatory or its affiliates during the Athlete's period of Ineligibility (Article 10.12.1).
- 4. In accordance with article 10.10, recover from the Athlete the costs associated with the ADRV.
- 5. All final decision of the IWUF ADDC are published on the IWUF website.

Pursuant to 2015 IWUF Anti-doping Rules Article 13.2.1, Appeals Involving International-Level Athletes or International Events, Mr. Seyedmoein TAGHAVI has the right to appeal this decision to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) within twenty-one (21) days from the date of receipt of this decision and notification in accordance with Article 13.7, Time for Filing Appeals.
