



2020 Equipment Support Program Guidelines

Overview

The Equipment Support Program, as the one of IWUF Solidarity Program, aims to provide wushu equipment to National (Territorial) Federations (NFs), to meet their training and competition requirements as well as to ensure safety standards.

This time, we have four categories for the Equipment Support Program: Level A, Level B, Level C and Level D.

Qualification

Level A:

-NFs that have paid the membership fee since 2017 or NFs that participated in IWUF official competition/congress in 2019.

Level B:

-NFs that have paid the membership fee since 2017.
-NFs that participate in IWUF official competition/congress in 2019.

Level C:

-NFs that have paid the membership fee since 2017.

- NFs that participate in IWUF official competition/congress in 2019.
- NFs that participate and organize the IWUF activities, such as World Wushu-Kungfu Day, and IWUF Online Wushu Classroom.

Level D:

- NFs that have paid the membership fee since 2017.
- NFs that participate in IWUF official competition/congress in 2019.
- NFs that participate and organize the IWUF activities, such as World Wushu-Kungfu Day, and IWUF Online Wushu Classroom.
- NFs that have been awarded to host IWUF official competition from 2019 - 2021.

Funding Amount

Level A: VIK, USD 4,500

Level B: VIK, USD 6,000

Level C: VIK, USD 7,000

Level D: VIK, USD 20,000

-The Funding Amount includes the cost of equipment, shipping, and insurance covered by the IWUF.

-Beneficiary federation need to cover: customs clearance fees, domestic taxes and duties, domestic transportation, and other related costs as well as maintenance of equipment.

Timeline and Process

Due to the limited fund allocated to this Equipment Support Program, IWUF will select the NFs based on an analysis of their needs. The Program is closed when all allocated budget is used.

NFs shall duly complete the application form and return it in digital format via email to solidarity@iwuf.org by no later than November 18, 2020. The application form must be signed by the President or Secretary General with a stamp (if applicable).
