

THE WORLD GAMES SERIES 2024 - WUSHU REGULATIONS

The World Games Series 2024 is the qualification competition of the World Games, Chengdu 2025. 1st place athletes in each combined events will qualify to participate in the World Games, Chengdu 2025.

A. DATE & PLACE

The Wushu Competition of the World Games Series 2024 will be held from October 10 - 14, 2024 in Hongkong, China.

B. VENUES

1. Competition Venue: Go Park Sai Sha, Shap Sze Heung, Sai Kung, Hong Kong
2. Training Venue: Go Park Sai Sha, Shap Sze Heung, Sai Kung, Hong Kong

C. COMPETITION EVENTS

1. Men's:
 - Changquan, Daoshu and Gunshu Combined.
 - Nanquan and Nangun Combined.
 - Taijiquan and Taijijian Combined.
2. Women's:
 - Changquan, Jianshu and Qiangshu Combined.
 - Nanquan and Nandao Combined.
 - Taijiquan and Taijijian Combined.

D. QUOTA

1. 24 male athletes and 24 female athletes.
2. 8 athletes for each combined event under Article C.
3. The last unused quota positions will be reallocated by the IWUF.

E. QUALIFICATIONS

1. The following athletes competing the events under Article C qualify for the World Games Series 2024. All qualified athletes are listed as attachment.
 - The 7th - 11th place athletes whose combined score rank from the 16th World Wushu Championships;
 - The top 3 athletes whose combined score rank from the International Wushu Invitational Tournament 2024.
2. In any combined event, if an athlete gave up the place, the place given up by the athlete will be seated by the athlete in the same combined event according to the combined score ranking in descending order.
3. Athletes who ranked in the top 6 competing the Taolu events under Article C for the 16th World Wushu Championships have qualified for the World Games, Chengdu 2025. These athletes are not eligible for the World Games Series 2024.

F. PARTICIPATION METHODS

1. Each qualified athlete may only participate within the event he or she has qualified for.
2. Each athlete should bring along with them a valid Health Certificate (including electrocardiogram, pulse and blood pressure) issued within 30 days prior to the start of the competition signed by a qualified doctor and a Life Accidental Injury Insurance Certificate. All athletes are required to submit a completed and signed waiver of liabilities form.
3. Each qualified athlete must be submitted into the IWUF by the IWUF Member Federations/Associations.

G. COMPETITION METHODS

1. Unless otherwise stated within these regulations, the competition will be conducted in accordance with the IWUF Wushu Taolu Competition Rules and Judging Methods 2019. The Rules and Methods may be interpreted solely at the discretion the IWUF. In case of any disagreement in the interpretation of the rules, the Chinese version shall prevail.
2. Within a single routine, an athlete may register and perform the same Difficulty Jump Movement at most two (2) times; however, the Degree of Difficulty Connection for these jumps may not be repeated (e.g. within a single optional routine an athlete may register and perform Xuàn Fēng Jiǎo 360° (Tornado Kick 360°) at most two (2) times, but the Degree of Difficulty Connection for each Tornado Kick 360° must be different).
3. All athletes are required to execute their optional routine's relevant compulsory/mandatory techniques as stipulated in the rules. Failure to do so will result in deductions as stated in the rules.
4. Accompanying music is required for Taijiquan and Taijijian routines which must be supplied by the athletes themselves. Failure to do so will result in deductions as stated in the rules.

H. COSTUMES, EQUIPMENT & COMPRTITION BIB

1. All athletes must follow the IWUF Brand Control Guidelines for Wushu Competition Uniforms.
2. All athletes must wear wushu competition costumes and use the equipment in compliance with the rules during all events.
3. The costumes and equipment must be brought and prepared by the athletes themselves.
4. Two (2) competition bibs (20cm*15cm) for each athlete's use will be provided by the Organizing Committee to Teams upon accreditation. All athletes must present their competition bibs to the Head Judge before entering the competition arena.

I. PLACING & AWARDS

Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the athletes ranked the top three (3) of each individual combined event respectively.

J. ENTRIES

All athletes' Degree of Difficulty must be submitter through the IWUF Online Registration System: **WG2024HK.One-Type.com** before **October 2nd, 2024 (Beijing Time)**

K. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

1. International Technical Officials
The Jury of Appeals and all judges shall be appointed by the IWUF.
2. National Technical Officials
The National Technical Officials shall be appointed by the Organizing Committee of the World Games Series 2024.

L. TECHNICAL MEETING

Each team should send one representative to attend this meeting.

Each team should send one representative to attend this activity. The Jury of Appeals will draw on behalf of the teams that are unable to send a representative to attend.

N. RESPONSIBILITY OF MEMBER FEDERATIONS

NFs are responsible for their officials, coaches, athletes, and observers adhering to the IWUF and to all relevant rules established by the IWUF and the Organizing Committee. NFs should ensure that their participants hold themselves to the highest standards in all their actions during the event.

1. Fundamental Principles

All NFs' team members participating in the World Games Series 2024 must observe and respect the IWUF constitution, rules, regulations, and representatives. Individuals deemed to have acted against the IWUF, its principles, interests or purpose may be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation.

2. Attitude of Athletes and Coaches

The athletes will compete under the responsibility of their NFs. NFs are fully responsible regarding the general attitude and comportment of their athletes. Coaches should respect the judging panel and all complaints must be conducted in accordance with competition procedures. Athletes and Coaches should comply with the IWUF Ethic Codes.

3. Image of Athletes

Each NF is responsible for obtaining the rights for the IWUF to use its athletes' images at the discretion of the IWUF for promotional purposes in all forms.

4. Insurance

Each NF is fully and sole responsible for insuring its athletes against injury and third-party risk (public liability) during the period of the World Games Series 2024. The IWUF and the Organizing Committee are not responsible in part or in whole of the said liability.

O. PASSPORT & VISA REQUIREMENTS

1. All the World Games Series 2024 participants must hold their valid passports, to ensure as few complications during visa application and travel as possible. It is suggested that all participants' passports are valid for at least six (6) months following their final day of travel.
2. Teams that require visa invitation letters should state their requests to the Organizing Committee of the World Games Series 2024.

P. FINANCIAL INFORMATION

1. Games Series 2024 is responsible for all athletes' flight (economy), accommodation and meal within Hong Kong, China, from October 10th to 14th.
2. The accommodation fees of all team officials shall be borne by the Teams themselves. Please find the team official package details below:
