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I. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. INTRODUCTION

The inclusion of wushu as an official sport at the Youth Olympic Games (YOG) Dakar 2026 marks a significant milestone in the global promotion of this sport and its development among young wushu athletes in Africa. This historic achievement underscores the importance of improving the competitive level of young African athletes through training programs.

In line with the International Olympic Committee's (IOC) "Building a Better World through Sport" initiative and the IOC Olympic Solidarity's "Young Athlete Development – Opportunities for International Federations" program, the International Wushu Federation (IWUF) plans to organize wushu training camps for young Africans. IOC Olympic Solidarity & IWUF African Youth Wushu Training Camp (Dakar 2025) is a collaborative program between IOC Olympic Solidarity and the IWUF that aims to strengthen opportunities for African wushu athletes to compete at the Olympic Games while fostering the development of the sport on a continental scale. This camp is aimed at potential African National Federations (NFs) working in partnership with their respective National Olympic Committees (NOCs), as well as age-eligible athletes with potential for the Dakar 2026 YOG.

By serving as a talent pool for the upcoming Dakar 2026 YOG, the camp will not only prepare athletes for elite competition but also lay the foundation for the long-term development of wushu in Africa, ensuring a lasting legacy for the sport on the continent. This program also aims to provide Senegal, as the host country, with a legacy that will enable it to develop wushu.

II. TECHNICAL INFORMATION

7. QUALIFICATIONS

7.1 Eligibility for NOCs (NFs)

-Only IWUF-invited NOCs (NFs) are eligible to participate in the camp.

7.2 Athlete Eligibility

-Age requirement: Athletes must be born between November 14, 2008, and October 31, 2011, inclusive (aligned with the Dakar 2026 YOG wushu competition).

7.3 Quota & Extra Quota

-Each invited NOC (NF) may enter a maximum total of 6 members:

Quota members (at most 3):

2 quota athletes (1 male, 1 female)

1 quota coach or official

Extra-Quota members (at most 3):

2 extra-quota athletes (1 male, 1 female)

1 extra-quota coach or official

* Extra-quota athletes must be in different events from quota athletes (e.g., if quota athletes are in Changquan & Gunshu, extra-quota athletes must be in Taijiquan & Taijishan).

*Extra-quota coach or official must meet at least one of the following criteria: be of opposite gender, specialized in a different event, or serves in an official role.

8. ENTRIES

8.1. Final Entry

- All final entries must be submitted through the IWUF Online Registration System:

- All sections of the online entry must be completed in full, including the uploading of the various required documents.

- Each participant is required to print a copy of the submitted entry and present it upon arrival and registration.
- The online registration will be opened on **September 18, 2025** and closed on **September 25, 2025, 23:59(Beijing Time)**.

11. ARRIVAL & REGISTRATION

11.1. All participants are required to arrive at the designated hotel and register with the Organizing Committee.

12. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

12.1. Quota Members: IWUF will cover expenses of round-trip flights, accommodation, meals, and local transportation service for quota members for each team. Other costs, such as visa fees, medical certificates, and insurance shall be covered by participants themselves.

NOCs/NFs shall purchase the round-trip flights first and get reimbursement from IWUF based on actual expenses, by submitting necessary required materials.

12.2. Extra-Quota Members: All expenses occurred for extra-quota members shall be covered by participants themselves.

12.3. Participants are required to pay the relevant accommodation fees by international bank transfer with their final entry submission. Proof of payment should be sent to the Organizing Committee by email and brought with the participants on arrival.

12.4. All participants are required to complete payment in advance to the Organizing Committee by 24:00

(Dakar Time) of **October 05, 2025**.

13. COSTUME REQUIREMENTS

13.1. All participants should wear flexible wushu clothes and shoes on the training days.

13.2. Participants who wear tight uniforms that are not suitable for training or shoes with hard or sharp edges may be refused to attend the training sessions.

14. PASSPORT & VISA REQUIREMENTS

14.1. All participants must hold a valid passport and should allow plenty of time for visa application and processing. To ensure as few complications during visa application and travel as possible, it is suggested that all participants' passports are valid for at least six months following their final day of travel.

15. RESPONSIBILITY OF MEMBER FEDERATIONS

National/Territorial Federations (NFs) are responsible for their participants adhering to the IWUF and to all relevant rules established by the IWUF and the Organizing Committee. NFs should ensure that their participants hold themselves to the highest standards in all their actions during the event.

15.1. Fundamental Principles

All NFs' Team members participating in this event must observe and respect the IWUF constitution, rules,

regulations, and representatives. Individuals deemed to have acted against the IWUF, its principles, interests or purpose may be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation.

15.2. Attitude of Participants

The participants will attend this event under the responsibility of their NFs. The NFs are fully responsible regarding the general attitude and comportment of their participants. All participants should respect the lecturer panel and comply with the IWUF Ethic Codes. All participants should behave themselves well and disciplined during the whole training period.

15.3. Image of Participants

Each NF is responsible for obtaining the rights for the IWUF to use its participants' images at the discretion of the IWUF for promotional purposes in all forms.

15.4. Insurance

The participants are fully and sole responsible for insuring themselves against injury and third-party risk (public liability) during the period of this event. The IWUF and the Organizing Committee are not responsible in part or in whole of the said liability.

16.1. All participants will be awarded with a participation certificate.

16.2. Any absence from a training session without a valid reason will result in forfeiting eligibility to obtain the participation certificate.
