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## I. GENERAL INFORMATION

### 1. INTRODUCTION

#### 1.1 Italy Overview

Italy, located in Southern Europe and shaped like a boot, is renowned for its rich history, vibrant culture, and breathtaking landscapes. Surrounded by the Mediterranean Sea, Italy's geography ranges from the towering Alps in the north to the sun-soaked beaches of the south, encompassing rolling hills, fertile plains, and picturesque coastlines. Its capital, Rome, is famously known as the "Eternal City," bearing witness to centuries of civilization as the center of the Roman Empire. ## 1.2 Pordenone Overview

Pordenone is a vibrant city located in the Friuli Venezia Giulia region of northeastern Italy, just a short distance from Venice. This strategic location makes it an easy and appealing stop for travelers eager to explore the wonders of northern Italy. ## 1.3 International Airport and Local Train station

**Venice Marco Polo Airport (IATA: VCE)** is the main international gateway serving the city of Venice and the surrounding northeastern Italian regions, including Friuli Venezia Giulia. The airport is situated approximately 75 kilometers (about 47 miles) from Pordenone, which can be reached in roughly an hour by car. This convenient distance makes it easy for travelers to access Pordenone directly from the airport. Venice Airport is well connected to major European and intercontinental destinations, making it an ideal arrival point for tourists visiting Pordenone and the wider region. Travelers can easily reach Pordenone from

Venice Airport by train, bus, or car, allowing for a smooth transition between the vibrant city of Venice and the charming attractions of Pordenone.



**Pordenone train station (Stazione di Pordenone)** is a key railway hub in northeastern Italy, offering excellent connections to major cities in the region and beyond. Conveniently located near the city center, the station is served by high-speed, regional, and intercity trains operated by Trenitalia and other rail companies. Passengers can easily travel to destinations such as Venice, Udine, Trieste, Milan, and Rome, making it a practical gateway for both daily commuters and tourists. Facilities at the station include ticket offices, waiting areas, cafes, and taxi services, ensuring a comfortable and efficient transit experience for travelers visiting or departing from Pordenone.





## 1.4 Weather

In June, Pordenone, Italy, experiences warm and increasingly humid weather as summer begins. Temperatures typically range from pleasant to hot, with average highs around **26°C-27°C** and lows around **17°C-18°C**. It is one of the wetter months of the year, with a roughly 33%-36% chance of precipitation on any given day, often featuring moderate rain.

## 1.5 Currency

The Italian currency is the Euro, abbreviated as EUR. The USD/EUR exchange rate is approximately \$1.00/€0.84.

## 1.6 Electricity

Italy operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz frequency, adhering to European standards. Outlets primarily accept Types C, F (Schuko), and L (three-pin) plugs. While Type C works for most, Type L (or a "bipasso" outlet) is standard for three-pronged grounded appliances.

## 1.7 Telephone

To call Italy from abroad, dial +39 (country code), then the local number.

## 2. INTRODUCTION TO IWUF INTERNATIONAL WUSHU JUDGES TRAINING & CERTIFICATION COURSE

Hosted by the International Wushu Federation (IWUF), the IWUF International Wushu Judges Training & Certification Course (IWJTCC) 2026 is held biennially during even-numbered years. This course provides international-grade certification for both taolu and sanda judges, aiming to offer all wushu judges worldwide an opportunity to qualify for officiating at international wushu competitions. Following review by the IWUF Judges' Committee meeting, the IWJTCC 2026 will be co-organized by the Federazione Italiana Wushu Kung Fu e Arti marziali Vietnamite with the oversight of the IWUF.

## II. TECHNICAL INFORMATION

### 6. QUALIFICATIONS

#### 6.1 Membership

Only those IWUF member federations (hereinafter referred to as "NF") which have paid their IWUF annual membership fees for 2025 and 2026 will be permitted to participate in the IWJTCC 2026.

The federation/association applying to join IWUF may be invited to take part in the course after their applications have been accepted by the IWUF.

#### 6.2 Eligibility of Participants

All participants must:

- Hold their representative countries/territories' passports.
- Be in good physical health.
- Be fluent in either English or Chinese language.

##### 6.2.1 New Participant

All new participants must:

- Be born in and after **1976**.
- Have at least 3 years of judging experience at a national/territorial level.
- Have officiated at their national/territorial championships or at a competition of similar magnitude at least twice.

##### 6.2.2 Renewing and Upgrading Participants

All existing IWUF judges must:

- Be **65** years of age (including **65** years of age) or under, i.e. born in and after **1961**.
- Hold the IWUF Judge's License valid in 2026.
- Have a period of 4 years lapsed since acquiring their last certification grade (only for those judges who wish to upgrade their current judge grade).

##### 6.2.3 Participants of Expired Certificate

- Those judges whose licenses have expired but whose NF received official permission from the IWUF to miss the past IWJTCC 2026 may apply to renew and are required to participate in the



course and pass the examinations. They will be conferred the same grade as their last certification without upgrading.

- Those judges whose licenses have expired may only apply as new participants. After the successful passing of the examinations, they will be certified as B-grade international wushu Taolu or Sanda judges, regardless of their previous grade.

## 7. QUOTA

### 7.1 New Participant

Each NF may at most submit in total:

- 5 new taolu participants
- 5 new sanda participants

### 7.2 Renewing and Upgrading Participants

There is no quota limit for the renewing and upgrading participants.

### 7.3 Wild Card

- IWUF possesses several new judges' wildcards for the IWJTCC 2026, recommended by the IWUF Judges' Committee.
- NFs may submit wildcard applications to the IWUF Judges' Committee.

## 8. PARTICIPATION METHODS

All participants must only be submitted to the course by their respective NFs.

Upon arrival at the Accreditation Desk of the course, each participant must present the following documents:

- Completed and signed **Waiver of Liabilities** (Annex 1)
- **Medical Certificate** (Annex 2) issued by a qualified medical doctor from a check-up performed within a period of **15 days** prior to the date of registration at the course
- **Life Accidental Injury Insurance Certificate**

## 9. EXAMINATION AND CERTIFICATION

Unless otherwise stated within these regulations, the examination and certification shall be conducted in accordance with **the IWUF Judges Management Policy 2024**.

## 9.1 Taolu Examination

### 9.1.1 Technical Examination

- All participants are required to perform **1 bare-hand and 1 weapon routine** from the list below:

#### **1<sup>st</sup> Set/3<sup>rd</sup> Set of International Wushu Competition Routines:**

- **Bare-hand routines:** Changquan, Nanquan, and Taijiquan
- **Weapon routines:** Jianshu, Daoshu, Qiangshu, Gunshu, Nandao, Nangun, Taijijian, and Taijishan

**NOTE:** The instructional videos may be found at <https://www.youtube.com/user/iwufwushu>.

- If deemed necessary, the IWUF Judges' Committee may require a participant to perform only half their selected routine. In such cases, whether the participant performs the first half or the second half of their selected routine, will be determined by drawing random lots.

### 9.1.2 Theoretical Examination

The content of the theoretical examination covers **the IWUF Wushu Taolu Competition Rules and Judging Methods 2024**.

### 9.1.3 Practical Examination

Judging is conducted by reviewing the athletes' competition videos.

## 9.2 Sanda Examination

### 9.2.1 Technical Examination

All participants are required to demonstrate **sanda basic skills (hand techniques, leg techniques, wrestling techniques, defensive techniques) both individually and with an opponent, calls and gestures**.

### 9.2.2 Theoretical Examination

The content of the theoretical examination covers **the IWUF Wushu Sanda Competition Rules and Judging Methods 2024**.

### 9.2.3 Practical Examination

Judging is conducted by reviewing the athletes' competition videos.

## 9.3 Certification



## 9.3.1 Judge Grades

The IWUF international judge grades are:

- Taolu: Grade B; Grade A
- Sanda: Grade B; Grade A

## 9.3.2 Certification Standards

### ● ***New Participants***

- Achieving a total score of **60+ points** passes B-grade certification.
- Achieving a total score below **60 points** fails B-grade certification.

### ● ***Upgrading Judges (B→A)***

- Achieving a total score of **85+ points** passes A-grade certification.
- Achieving a total score of **60–84 points** retains B-grade certification.
- Achieving a total score **below 60 points** revokes the license.

### ● ***Renewing A-grade Judges***

- Achieving a total score of **85+ points** renews A-grade certification.
- Achieving a total score of **60–84 points** downgrades to B-grade judge.
- Achieving a total score **below 60 points** revokes the license.

### ● ***Renewing B-grade Judges***

- Achieving a total score of **60+ points** renews B-grade certification.
- Achieving a total score **below 60 points** revokes the license.

## 9.3.3 Examination Exemption

- All renewing and upgrading judges **born in or before 1976**:
  - Exempt from the technical examinations.
  - Must take the theoretical and practical examinations.
- All new participants are required to take the technical examinations.

## 9.3.4 Certification Issuance

All participants will receive a participation certificate, and judges who pass the examinations will receive:

- Newly certificated B-grade judges receive:
  - IWUF B-grade Judge Licenses (Taolu/Sanda)
  - IWUF judge badge (60 USD)
- Upgraded and renewed judges receive:
  - IWUF A/B-grade Judge License (Taolu/Sanda)
  - IWUF judge badge (60 USD)

## 10. COSTUMES REQUIREMENTS

- All participants should wear flexible wushu clothes and shoes on the training days and technical examinations.
- Participants who wear shoes with hard or sharp edges may be refused to attend the training sessions and technical examinations.

### 11.1 Final Entry

#### 11.1.1 Open and Close Dates

- ***Open: March 6, 2026***
- ***Close: April 30, 2026, at 23:59***

#### 11.1.2 Uploading Documents

- ***Photos*** of the participants (white background, head filling 70–80% of the photo, at least 480 pixels in width and 600 pixels in height)
- ***Passports*** of the participants (must be valid for ***at least 6 months*** following their final day of



travel)

### 11.1.3 Requirements for Registration

- All sections of the online entry must be completed **in full**.
- All payments due to the LOC must be paid in full for registration to be considered as completed.
- Each participant is required to print a copy of the submitted entry and present it to the LOC upon registration.

## 11.2 Late Entry and Changes Policy

After the final entry deadline, NFs with requests for late entries or changes must submit a written document for approval and shall pay the corresponding fees before the late entry and changes deadline, otherwise the request will be denied.

### 11.2.1 Open and Close Dates

- **Open: May 1, 2026**
- **Close: May 14, 2026, at 23:59**

### 11.2.2 Relevant Fees and Requirements

- Any request to change the entry (including the late entry) will be handled as follows:
  - The late entry is subject to the approval of the IWUF and, if accepted, it will incur a late-entry fee of **USD 100** per participant.
  - Replacing a participant is subject to approval by the IWUF and, if accepted, it will incur a replacement fee of **USD 100** per participant.
  - If changes are required due to incorrect or missing registration information, those changes are subject to approval by the IWUF and, if accepted, they will incur a fee of **USD 50** per change.

## 12. ARRIVALS AND ACCREDITATION

### 12.1 Arrivals

All accredited personnel are required to register with the LOC at the LOC-designated hotels no later than **May 29, 2026, at 23:59.**

## 12.2 Accreditation

Accreditation Desks will open **on May 29, 2026, at 9:00.**

Upon arrival at the Accreditation Desk, the participant is required to complete the following process:

1	Present his/her passport
2	Submit a paper copy of Final Entry Form
3	Submit signed Waiver of Liabilities (Annex 1)
4	Submit valid Medical Certificate (Sample) (Annex 2)
5	Pay the relevant participation fees in full (if applicable)
6	Pay the relevant penalty fees in full (if applicable)
7	Submit a bank receipt of payment (either in paper or electronic documents)
8	Sign and confirm all the above items are completed

Accreditation cards will be given to the participants upon completion of the accreditation process. All personnel must participate in the official activities with their accreditation card during the IWJTCC 2026.

## 13. MISCELLANEOUS

### 13.1 Compliance and Consequences

All participants are required to abide by the conditions stipulated by the IWUF and LOC. IWUF reserves the right to deny course participation to any participants who fail to abide by the aforementioned conditions. All costs related thereto shall be borne by the participants or their respective federations.

### 13.2 Absence from Course

Absence from any single course or training session without prior notification to the IWUF will result in forfeiture of examination eligibility.

### 13.3 Equipment for Examination

All participants are required to bring either a notebook, laptop, or tablet (android or windows) which has a screen size of 10" (inches) or greater. Specs as below:

### III. PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

#### 14. ACCOMMODATION

##### 14.1 Hotel Reservation

All accredited personnel are required to stay at the LOC-designated hotels.

- **Check-in: After 15:00**
- **Check-out: Before 11:00**

**NOTES:** Teams wishing to:

- Check-in **before 15:00 on May 29, 2026** must book accommodation **from May 28**.
- Check-out **after 11:00 on June 4, 2026** must book accommodation **until June 5**.

##### 14.1.1 Non-Compliance Policy

Participants choosing not to book the LOC-designated hotels due to special reasons shall pay a one-time Waiver Fee of **EUR 300** per person. In such cases:

- Participants shall assume full responsibility for their own accommodation, meals, and transportation.
- LOC shall not be liable for any consequences arising therefrom.

##### 14.1.2 Reservation Principles

- Hotel reservations are available on a **first-come, first-served** basis.
- Early reservations are **strongly recommended** due to limited availability.

##### 14.1.3 Meal Arrangements

LOC will provide meals for all accredited personnel:

- From the evening of their arrival date to the breakfast on their departure date
- 3 meals daily (breakfast, lunch, and dinner)

##### 14.1.4 Early Arrival and Late Departure Requirements

Participants wishing to arrive or depart outside the scheduled dates must:

- Submit their intended arrival and departure dates during the final registration process.
- Confirm accommodation bookings accordingly, with daily rates applicable.



## 14.2 Room Assignment Rules

Participants reserving double rooms will be paired with other participants by the LOC, if the individual chooses not to pay for a single room.

## 14.3 Hotels Information

Pursuant to agreements concluded with the local tourism authorities and in light of the urban scale of the event, the organizing committee hereby notifies all participants that the entire hotel network within the Municipality of Pordenone will be used for official event accommodations. Such accommodations shall provide a uniform standard of comfort for all participants, without exception.

The LOC will offer an All-Inclusive Package rate for 7 days (6 nights), covering the period from May 29 to June 4. The details are as follows:

- It encompasses, without limitation, meals and accommodations as specified in this circular, course materials, local transportation, and transportation to and from the designated destination, as further described herein.
- The package price is calculated based on shared double room occupancy.
- Participants who wish to upgrade their room to a single room, shall pay a one-time fee of EUR 300.
- Any Team wishing to arrive early or depart late must contact the Organizing Committee separately to arrange for the relevant cost details.
- Participants are required to notify the organizers in writing of any special dietary requirements or food allergies at the time of registration. The organizers shall not be held liable for any failure to accommodate specific needs arising from a participant's omission or delay in providing such information.

## 15. TRANSPORTATION

### 15.1 Transport Services for Arrivals and Departures

Transport services between **Venice Marco Polo Airport/Pordenone Train Station** and the official

hotels will be provided by the LOC for all accredited personnel on their arrival and departure dates.

- **Pick-Up: May 29, 2026** (from the airport to the hotels)
- **Drop-Off: June 4, 2026** (from the hotels to the airport)

## 15.2 Shuttle Services

Shuttle buses will operate between the official hotels and the course place. Schedules will be distributed on arrival.

## 16. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

### 16.1 Participants

- Any international or domestic airfare and related travel expenses, as well as the participation fees of all participants, shall be borne by themselves.
- The participation fees include accommodation, meals, pick-up/drop-off to and from the designated airport, local transportation, entry (excluding the late entry and changes fees) and certificate, etc.

### 16.2 Additional Costs

Participants arriving early or departing late may be subject to additional costs related thereto which shall be borne by the participants themselves.

### 16.3 Payment Methods

- All NFs are required to complete full payment in advance to the LOC **by 23:59 on April 30, 2026** through international wire transfer. Until complete payment is received, hotel rooms will not be reserved, and accreditation will not be issued.
- NFs that are unable to pay through international remittance due to government policies and restrictions should communicate with the LOC in advance to make arrangements, otherwise accreditation will not be issued.
- All international wire transfer and bank fees are to be paid by the NFs transferring the funds themselves.
- Proof of full payment should be sent to the LOC by email and brought along to the LOC by the participant. LOC requires that all participation fees are to be paid in advance in order to secure accommodation as required by the official hotels. LOC will be unable to guarantee a NF's required accommodation without pre-payment in full. NFs are requested to be mindful of this when submitting their final entry.

### 17.1 Fundamental Principles

All NF members participating in this course must observe and respect the IWUF constitution, rules, regulations, and representatives. Individuals deemed to have acted against the IWUF, its principles, interests or purpose may be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation.

### 17.2 Attitude of Participants

The participants will attend this course under the responsibility of their NFs. NFs are fully responsible regarding the general attitude and comportment of their participants. All participants should respect the lecturer panel and comply with the IWUF Ethics Codes. Participants should behave well and be disciplined during the whole training period.

### 17.3 Image of Participants

Each NF is responsible for obtaining the rights for the IWUF to use its participants' images at the discretion of the IWUF for promotional purposes in all forms.

## 18. INSURANCE

Each NF is fully and solely responsible for insuring its participants against injury and third-party risk (public

liability) during the period of the IWJTCC 2026. IWUF and LOC are not responsible in part or in whole for the said liability.

## 19. PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS

All participants must hold a valid passport and should allow plenty of time for visa application and processing.

To avoid complications during visa application and travel as much as possible, it is suggested that all participants' passports are valid for **at least 6 months** following their final day of travel.

NFs that require visa invitation letters should state their requests **from March 6 to April 19, 2026**.

All interested NFs seeking to obtain an entry visa are hereby required to submit the following documents and information to the official event email address: [segreteria@fiwuk.com](mailto:segreteria@fiwuk.com).

- A copy of a valid passport, clearly indicating the expiration date, which must comply with the entry requirements of the applicant's country of origin
- A copy of the confirmed flight itinerary.
- Proof of insurance.
- Proof of payment for both accommodation and registration fees related to the event.
- Indication of the specific consular office to which the visa application will be submitted.

Upon confirmation of registration by the International Wushu Federation (IWUF), an official invitation letter will be issued and transmitted directly to the designated consular office.

**NOTE: We strongly recommend teams that need to apply for visas do so as early as possible.**
